Chairman Dymond called the Regular Meeting of the Franklin Township Board of Supervisors to order on Thursday, July 5, 2018 at 7:00 p.m., at Camp Orchard Hill.

Motion was made by Mr. Williams, seconded by Mr. Miller to waive the reading of the minutes of the June 7, 2018 Regular Meeting, and to accept the minutes as posted. The motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Melvin gave the Treasurers report reciting the combined balances for all funds as of June 30, 2018 totaled \$549,766.71. Mr. Williams made a motion, seconded by Mr. Dymond to approve the June 2018 Treasurers report, to approve payment of expenses totaling \$32,010.89 and to approve payrolls and payroll taxes in the amount of \$ 11,782.14. The motion passed unanimously.
