Chairman Dymond called the Regular Meeting of the Franklin Township Board of Supervisors to order on Thursday, November 2, 2017 at 7:00 p.m., at the Franklin Township Fire Hall.

Motion was made by Mr. Miller, seconded by Mr. Dymond to waive the reading of the minutes of the October 5, 2017 Regular Meeting, and to accept the minutes as posted. The motion carried unanimously.
